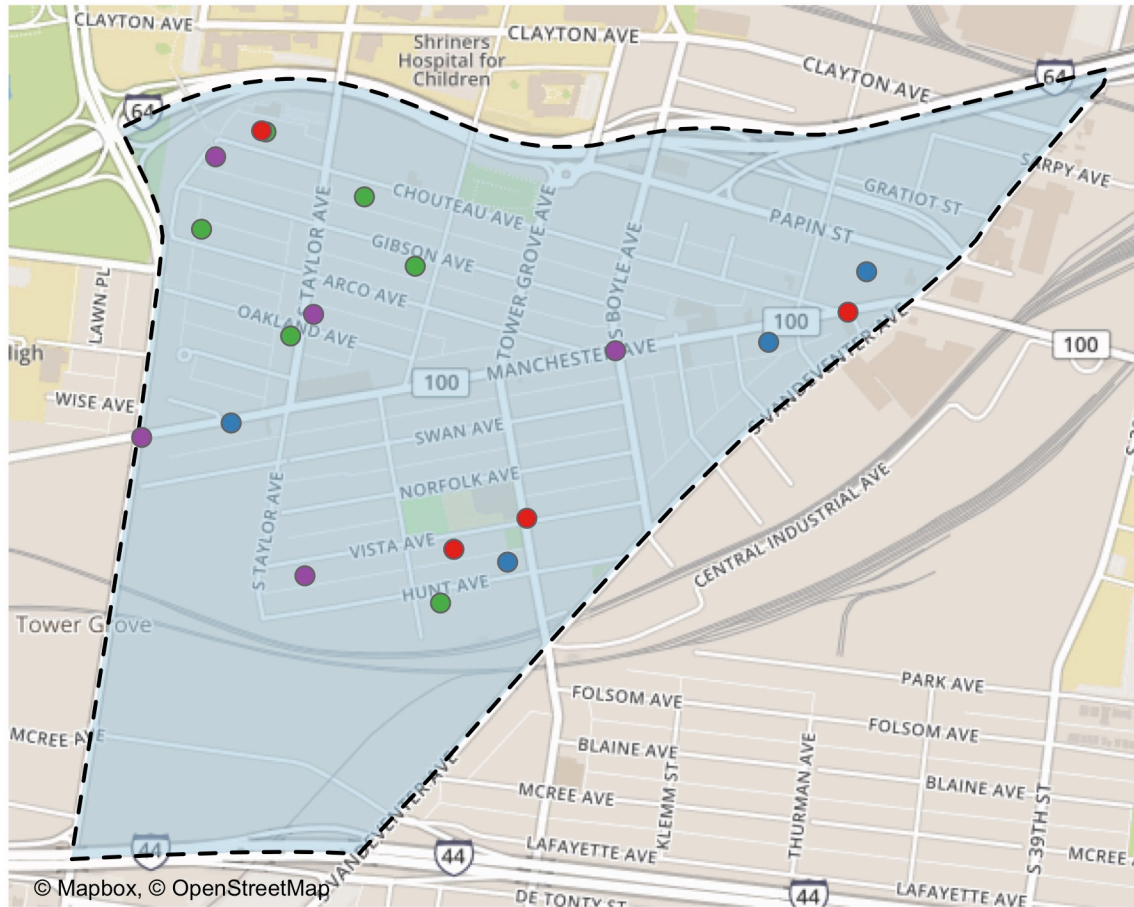

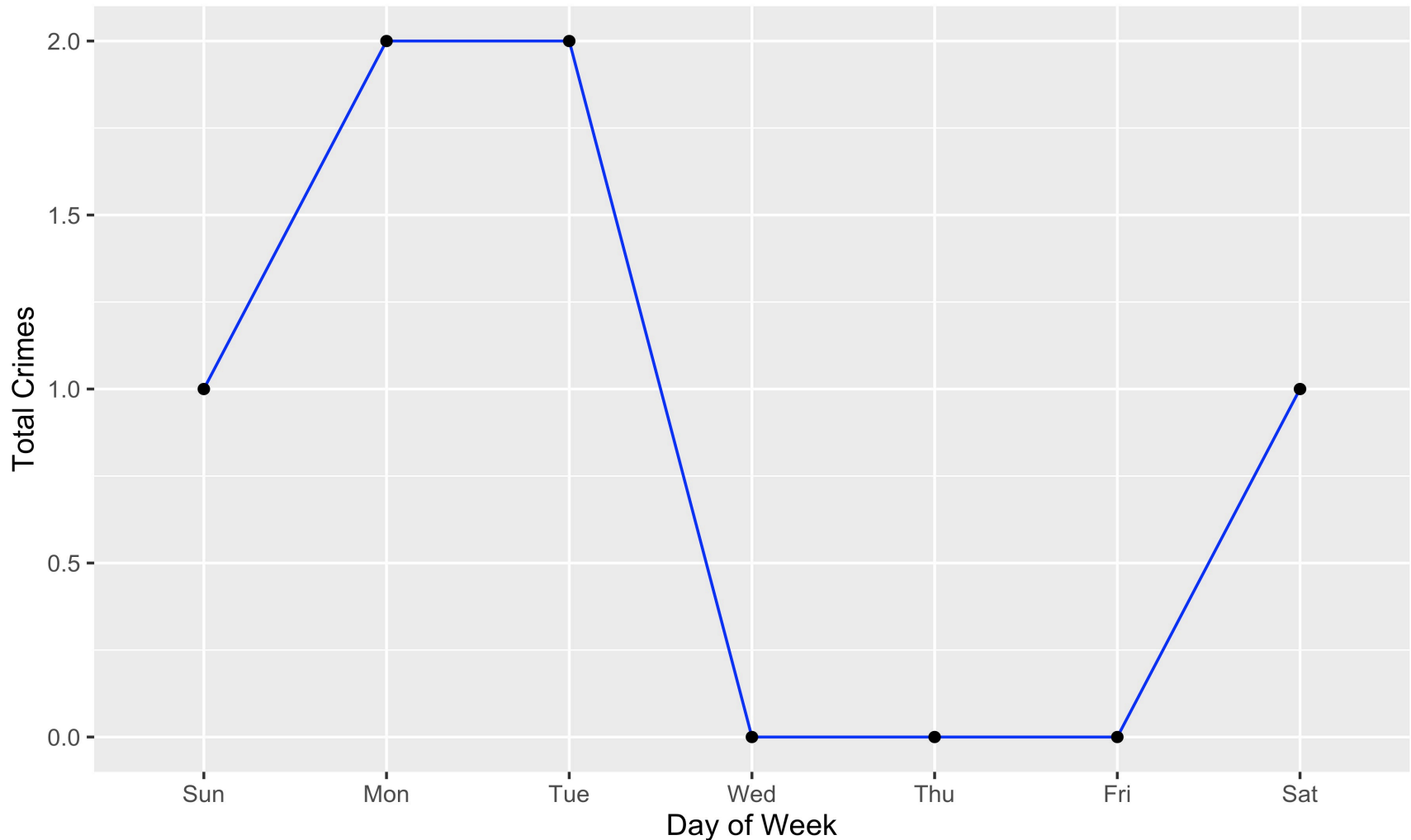

# Botanical Heights: Total Crime Map

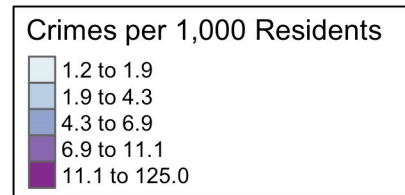
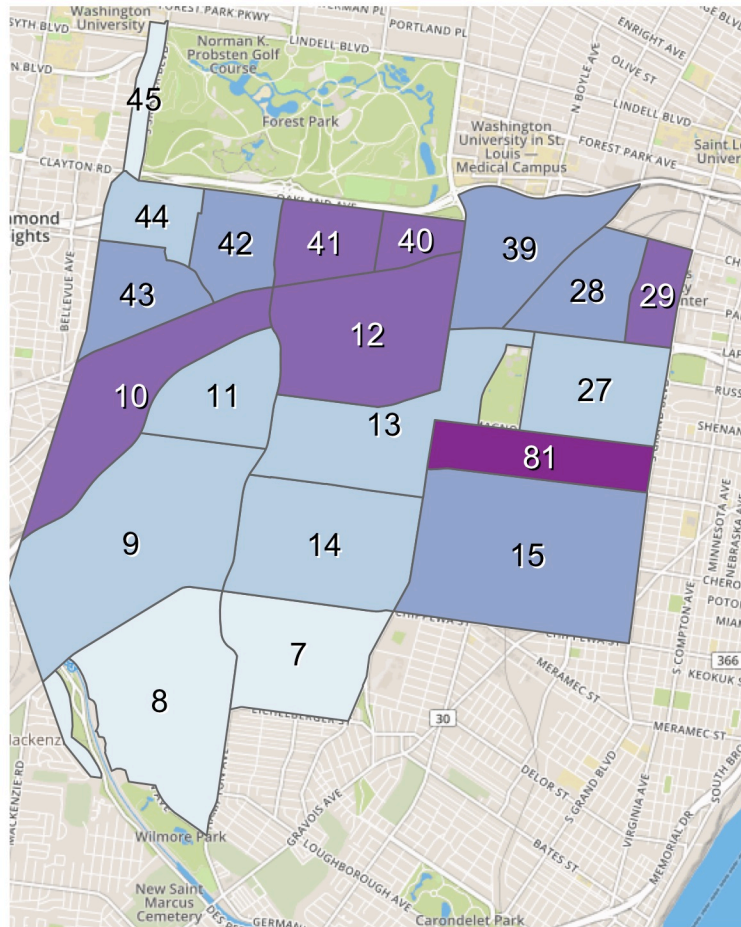




# Botanical Heights: Crime by Days of the Week

There are 23 neighborhoods in District 2. The South Hampton neighborhood is split between District 2 and District 1.

- **The minimum number of crimes** in one neighborhood was 1 (Tower Grove Park)
- **The maximum number of crimes** in one neighborhood was 65 (Tower Grove South)
- **The mean number of crimes** in one neighborhood was 15.45
- **The minimum rate of crimes** in one neighborhood was 1.16 (Southampton)
- **The maximum rate of crimes** in one neighborhood was 125 (Tower Grove Park)
- **The mean rate of crimes** in one neighborhood was 11.34

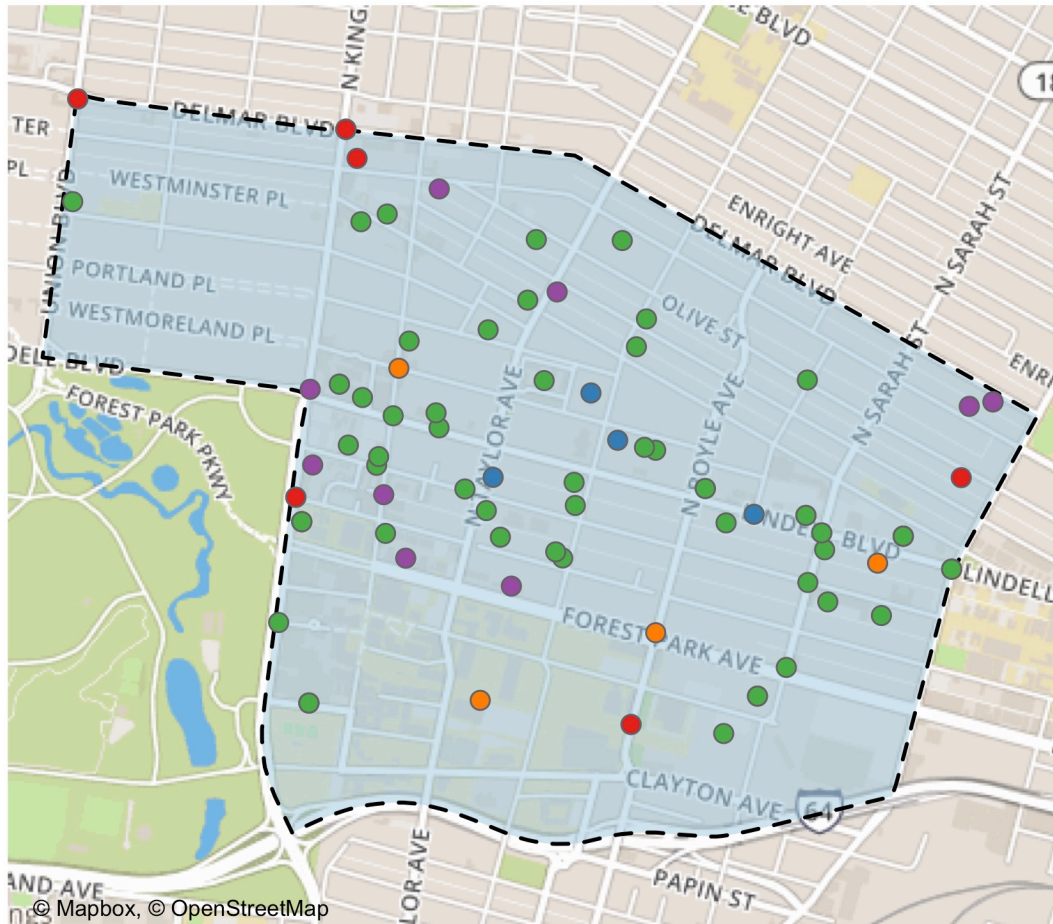

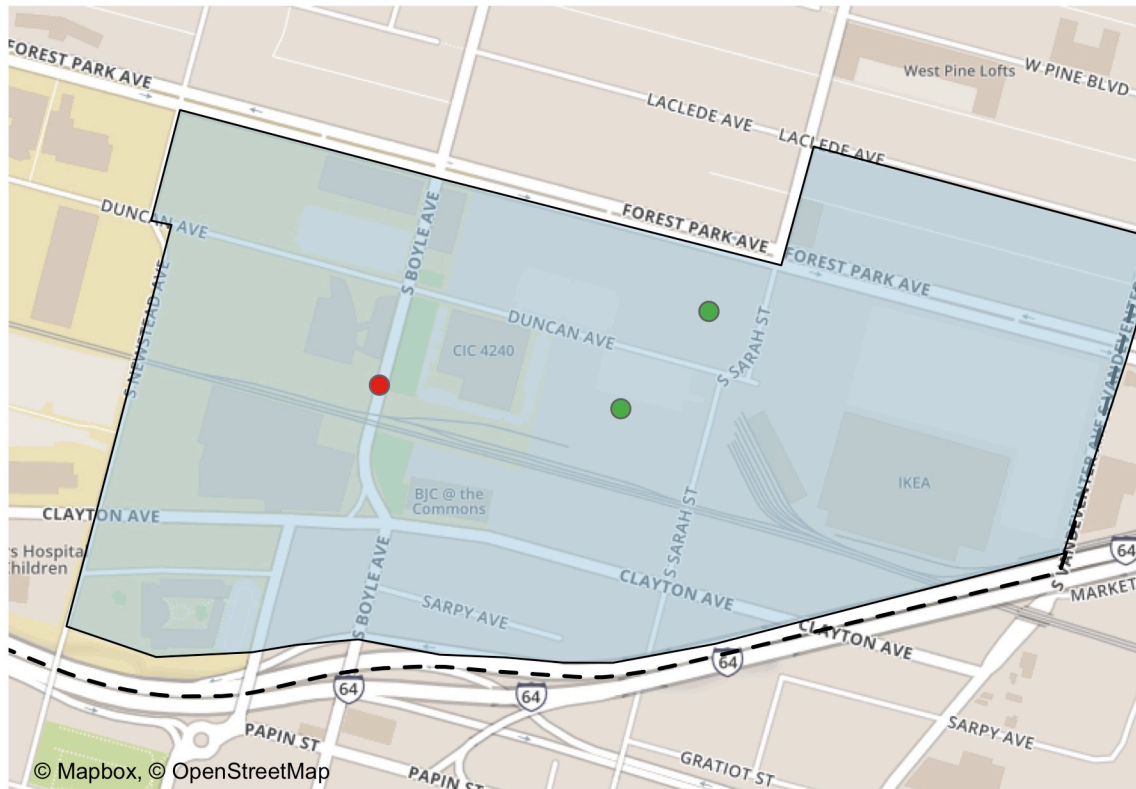

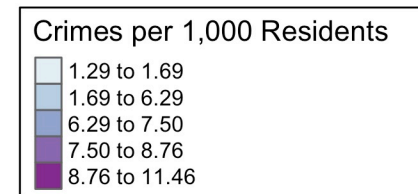
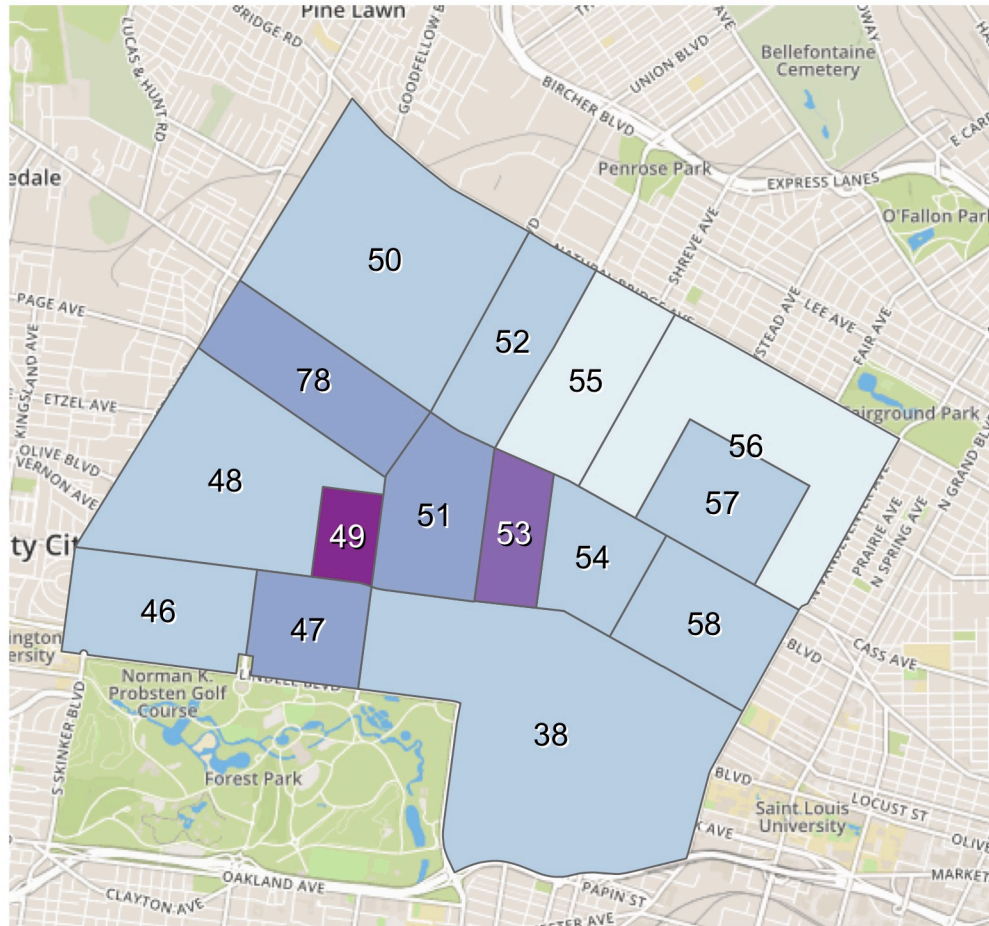
# Cortex: Total Crime Map

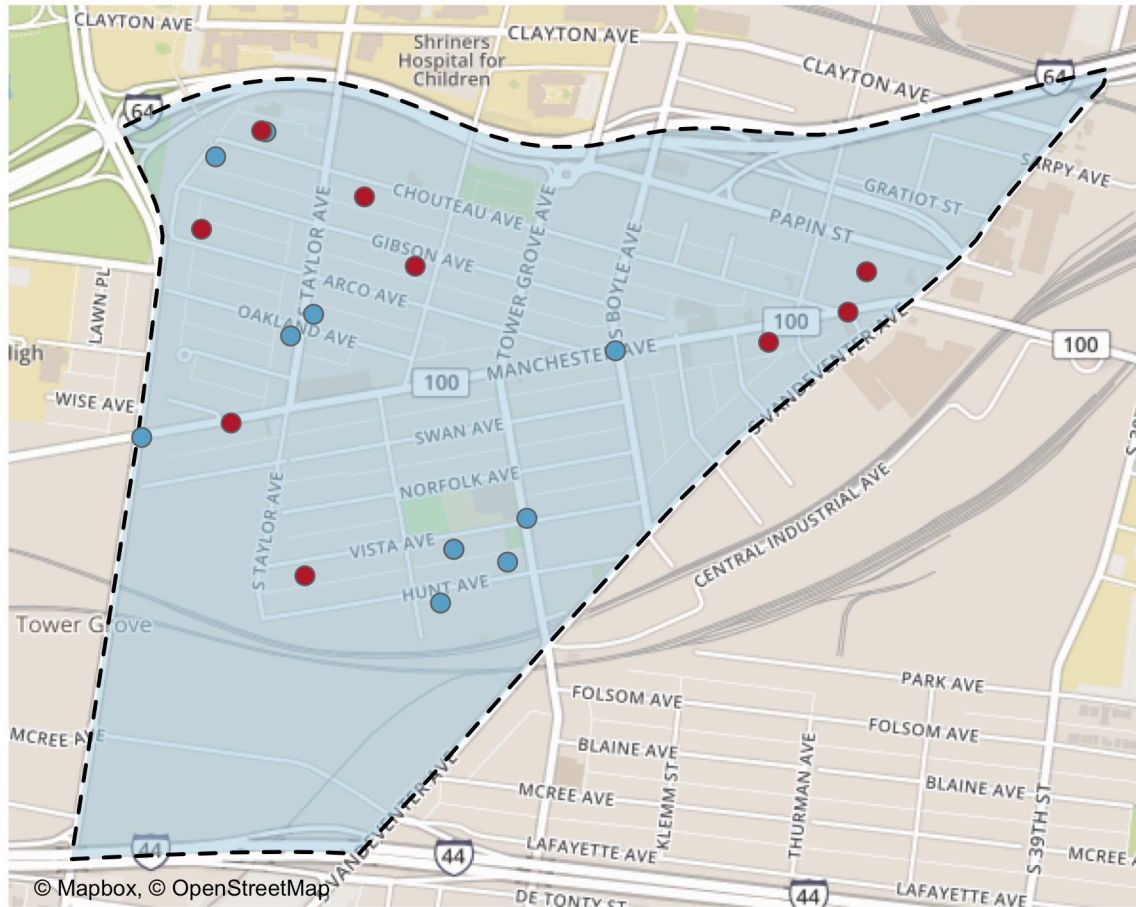

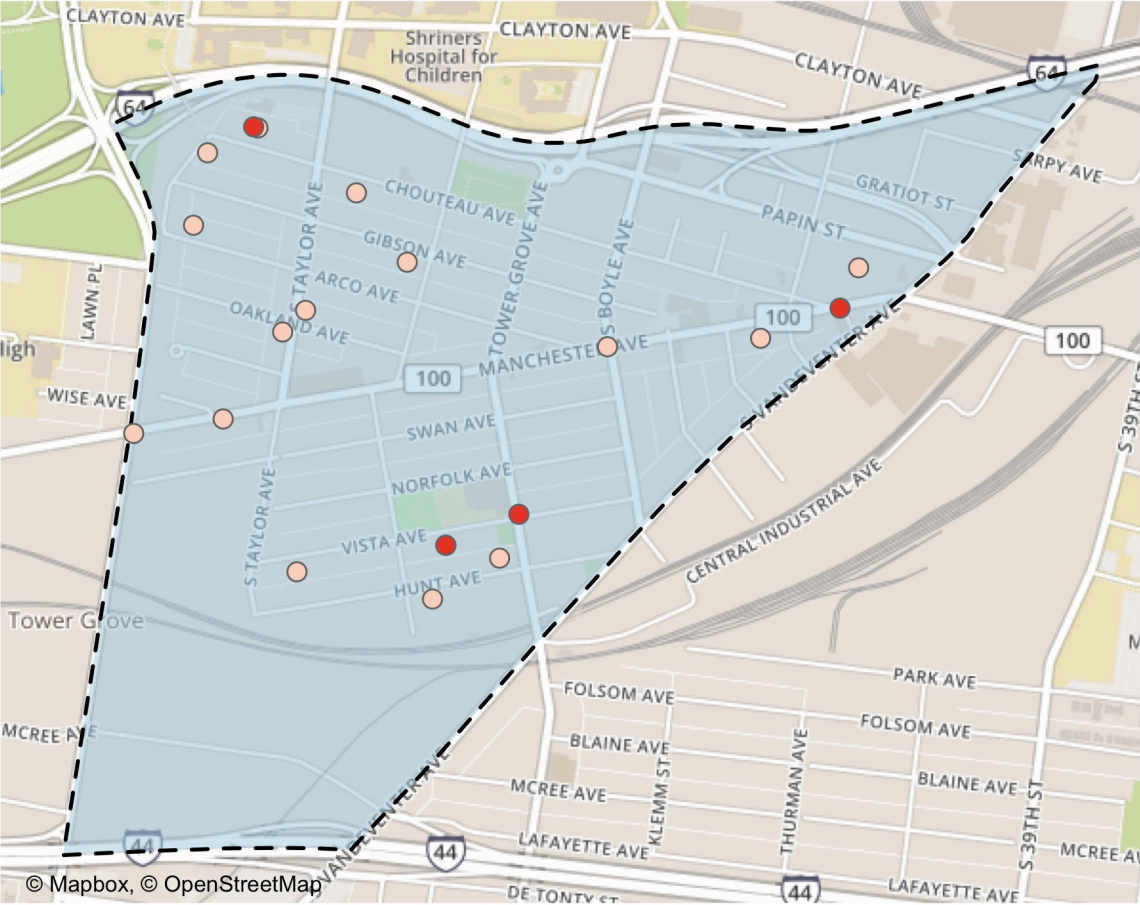


# Forest Park Southeast: Time of Crimes Map

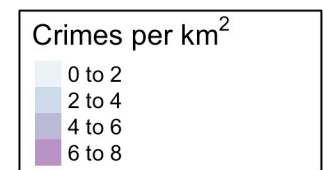
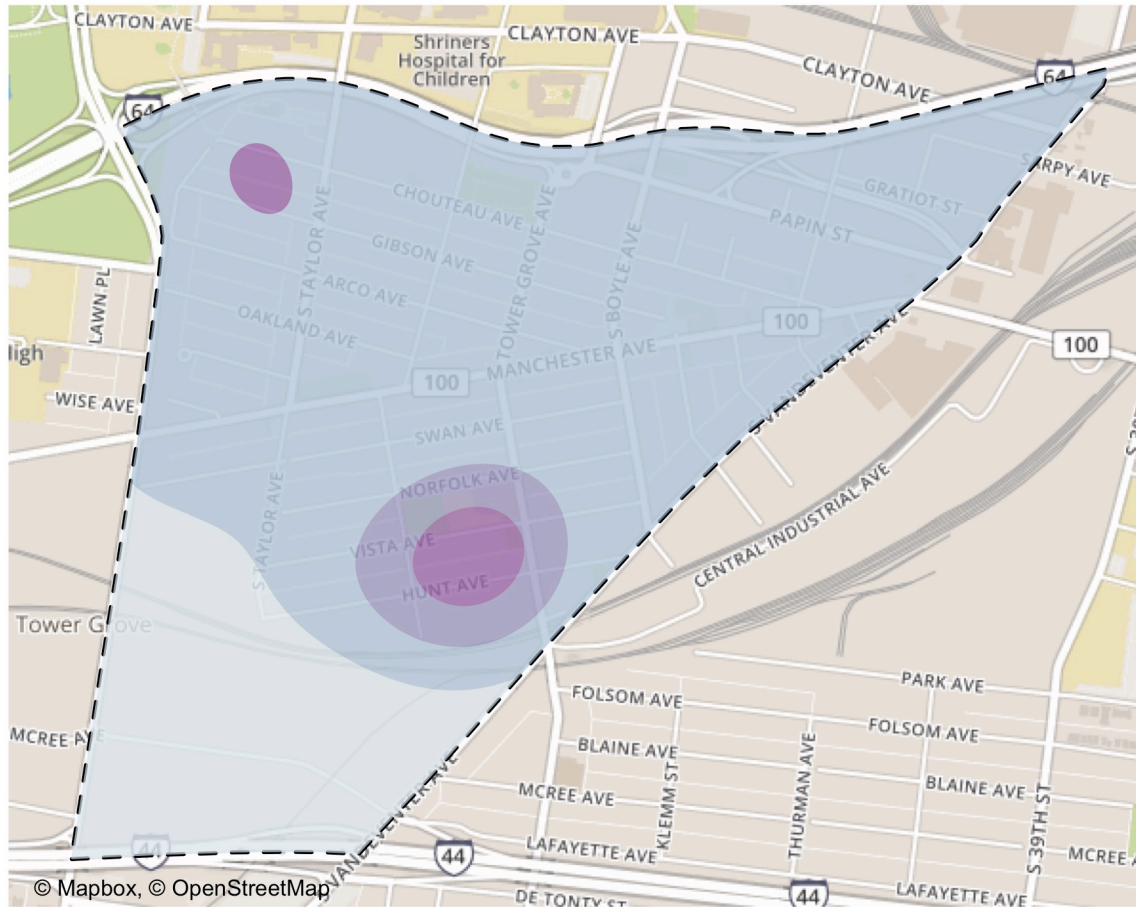

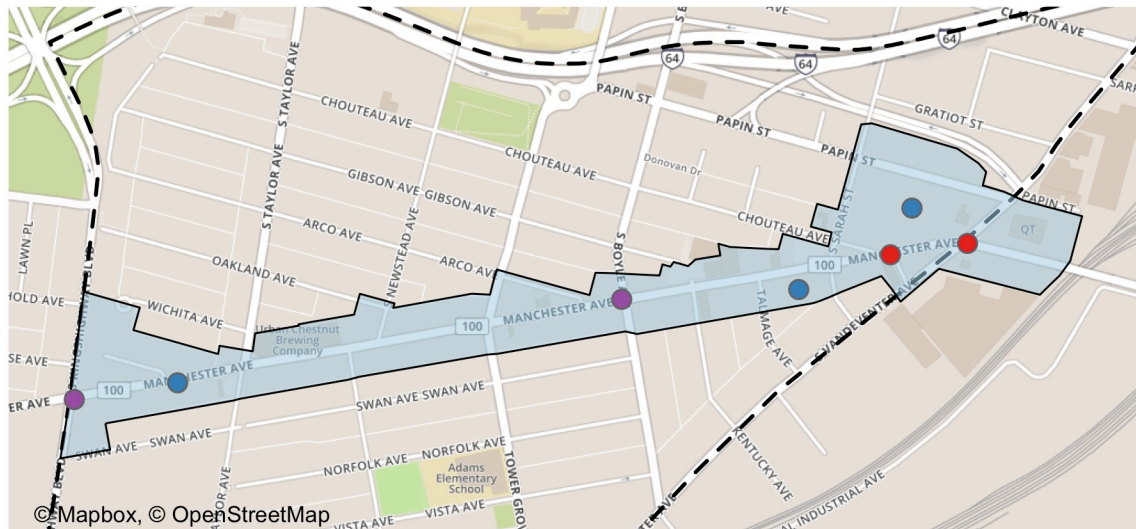
# Forest Park Southeast: Violent Crime Map

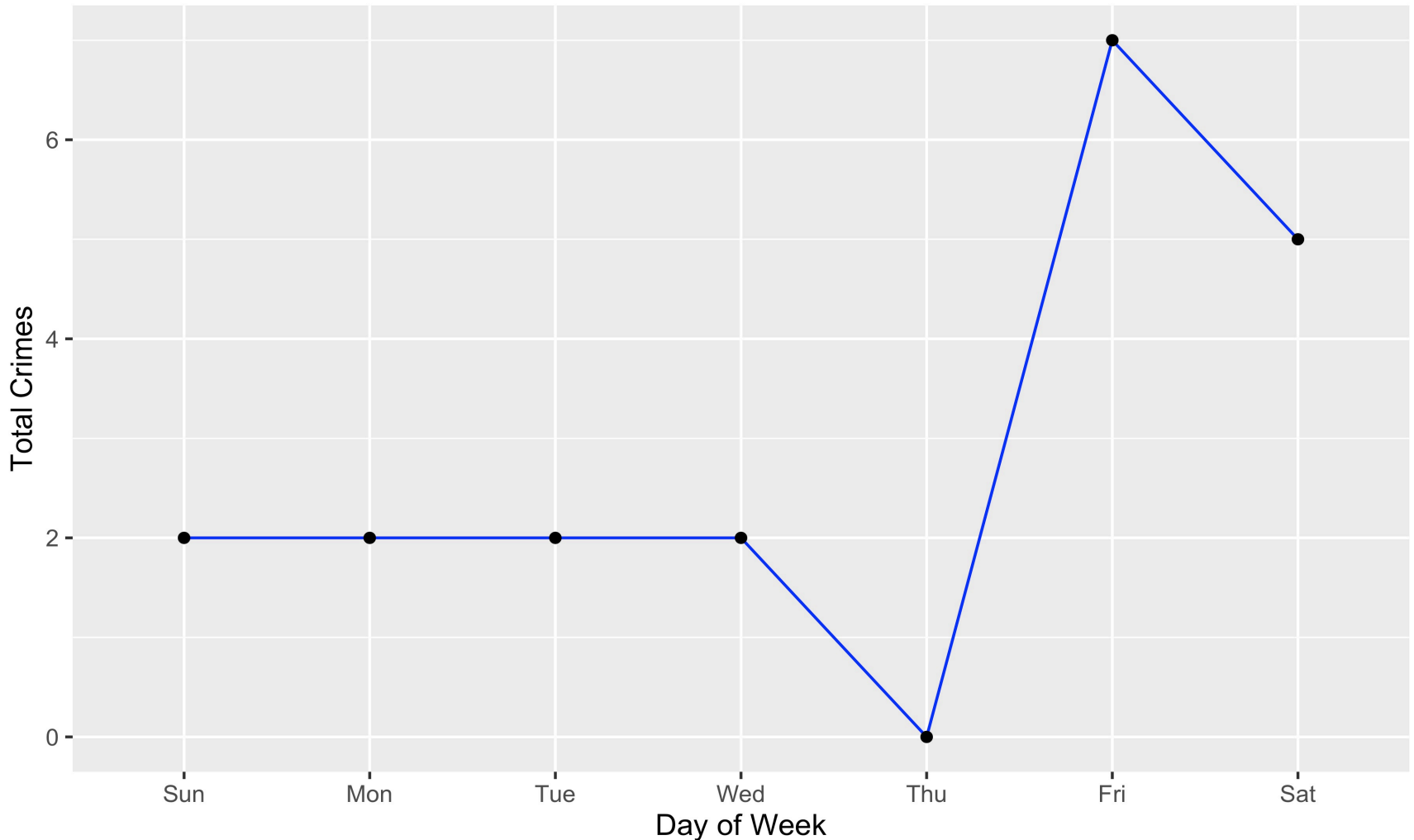

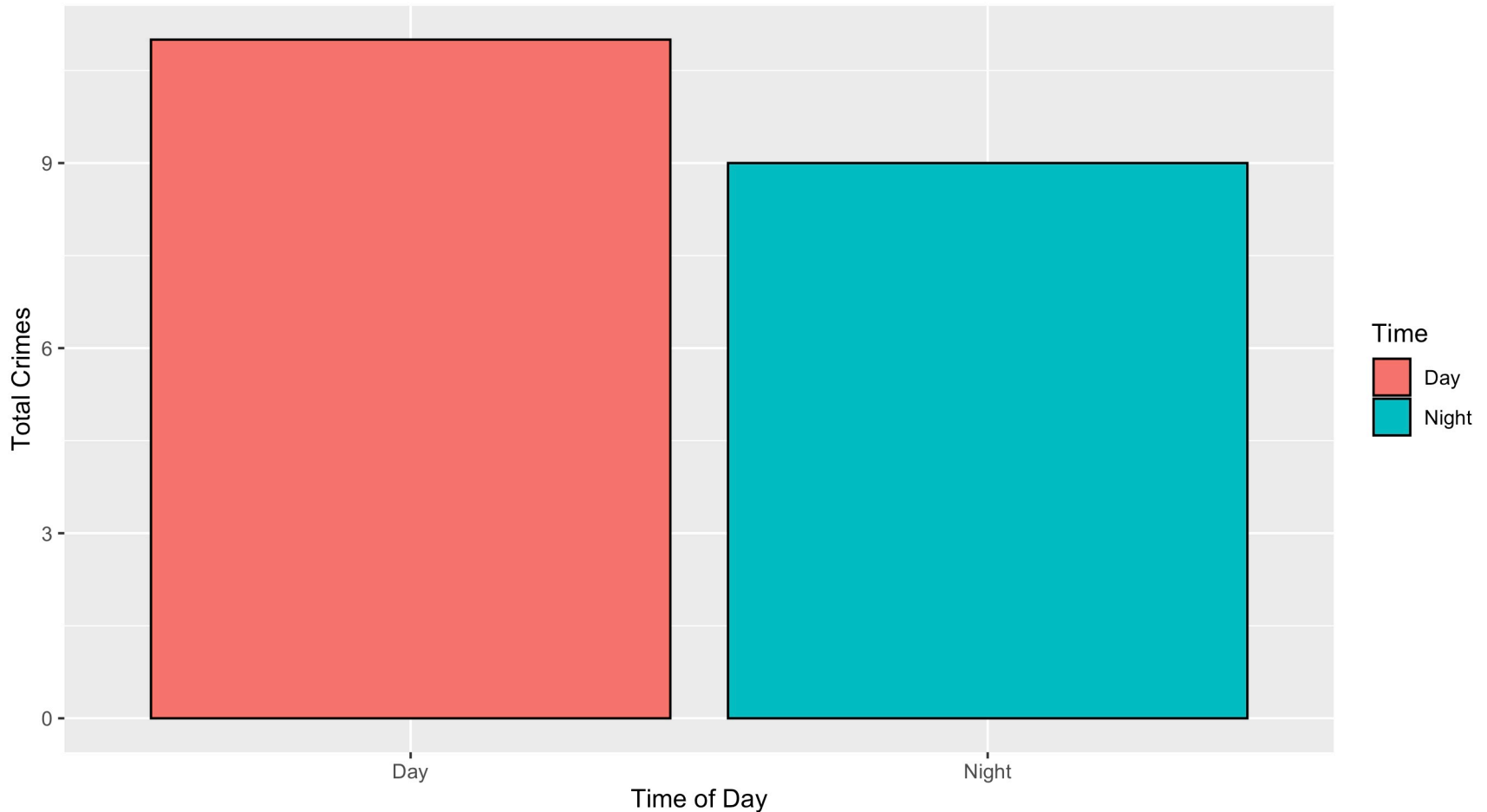

# Forest Park Southeast: Total Crimes by Days of the Week

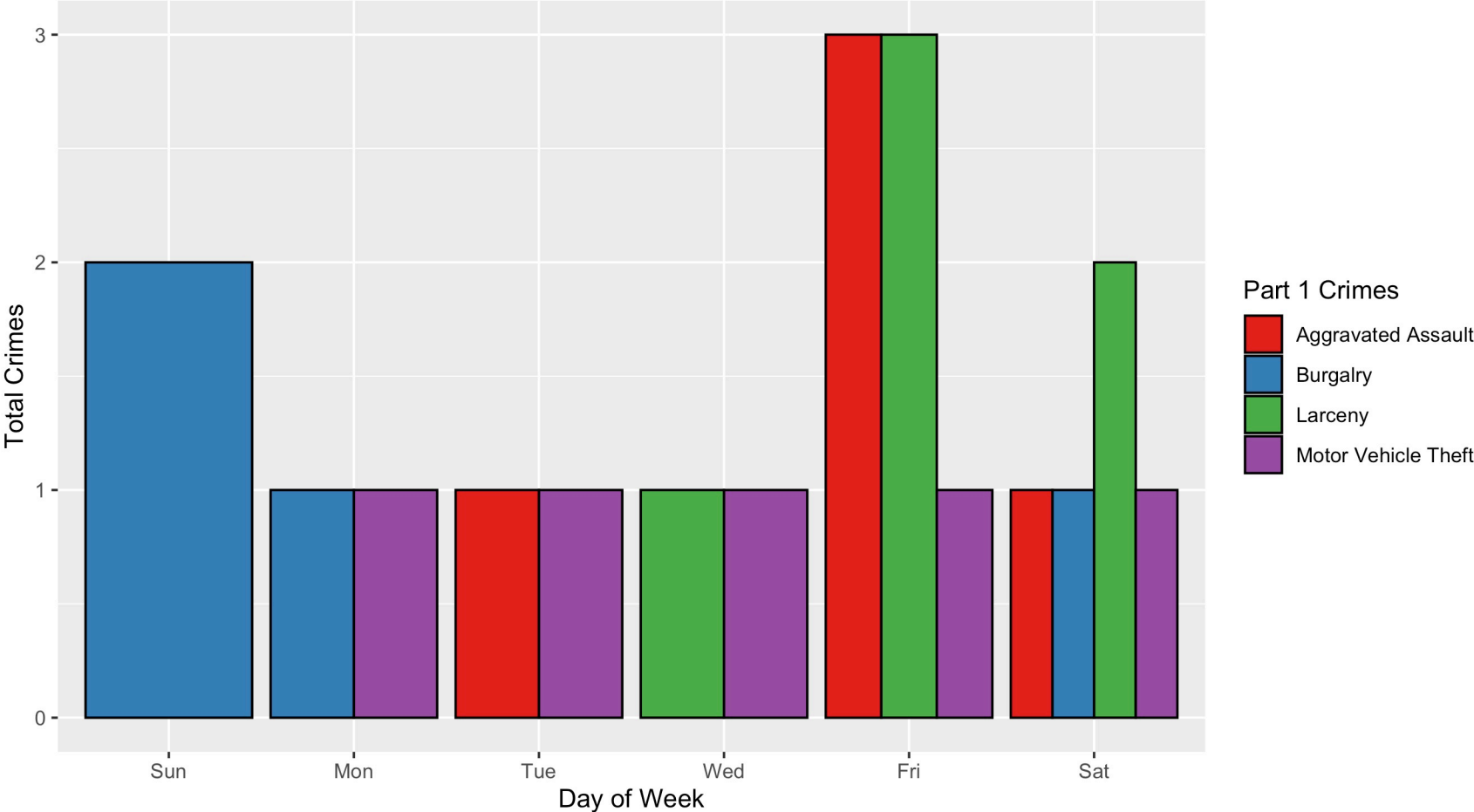


# Forest Park Southeast: Crimes by Time of Day





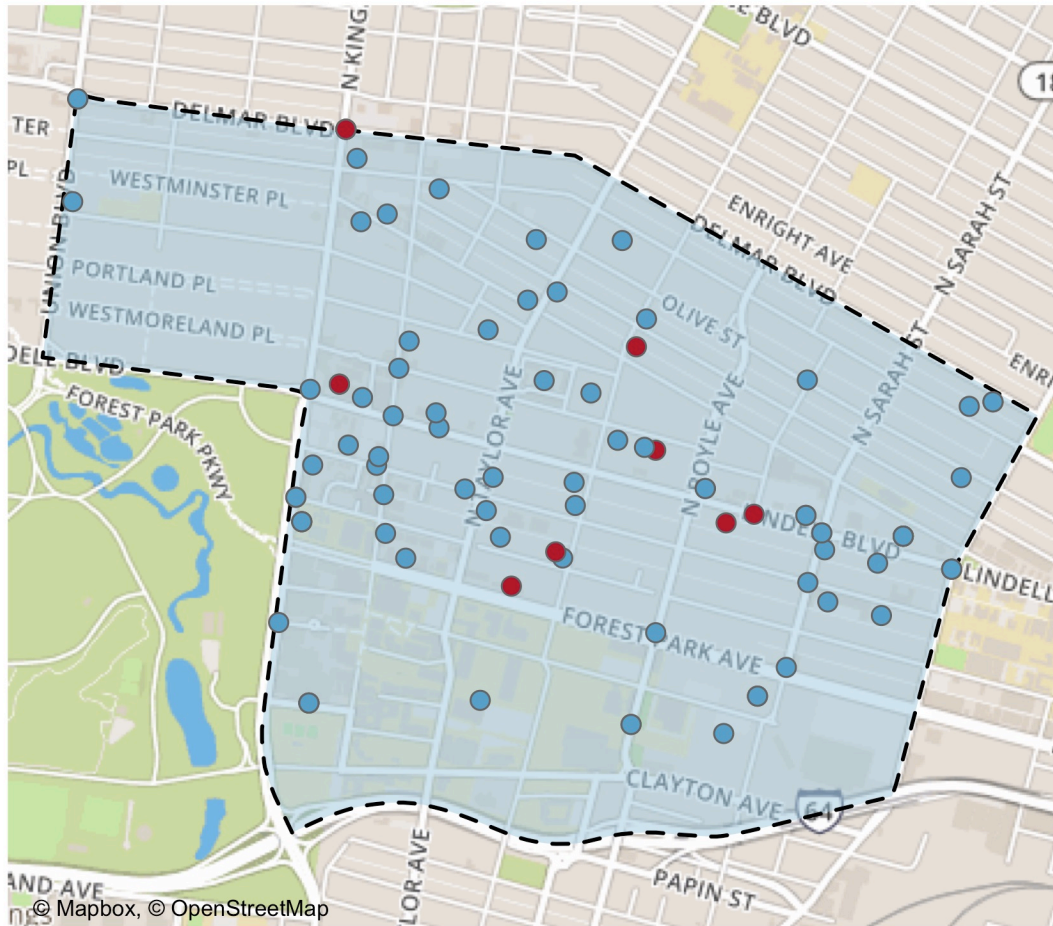

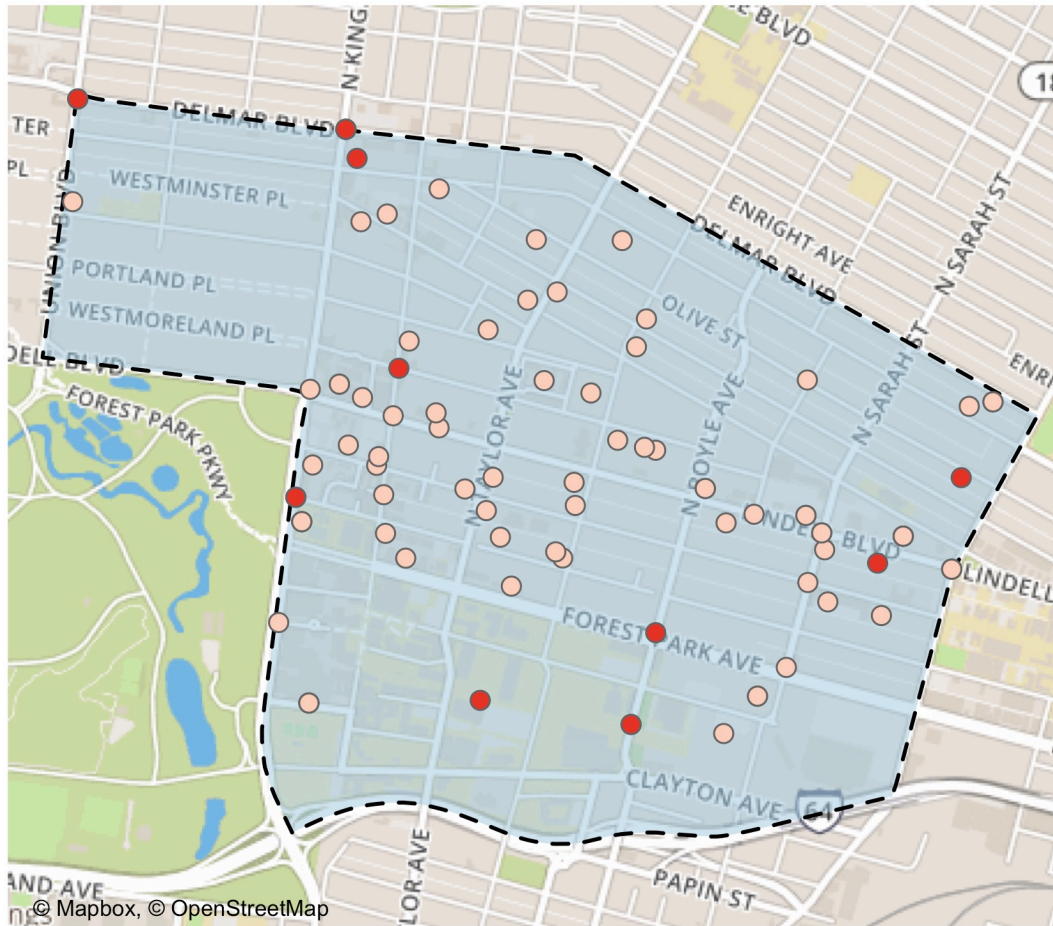

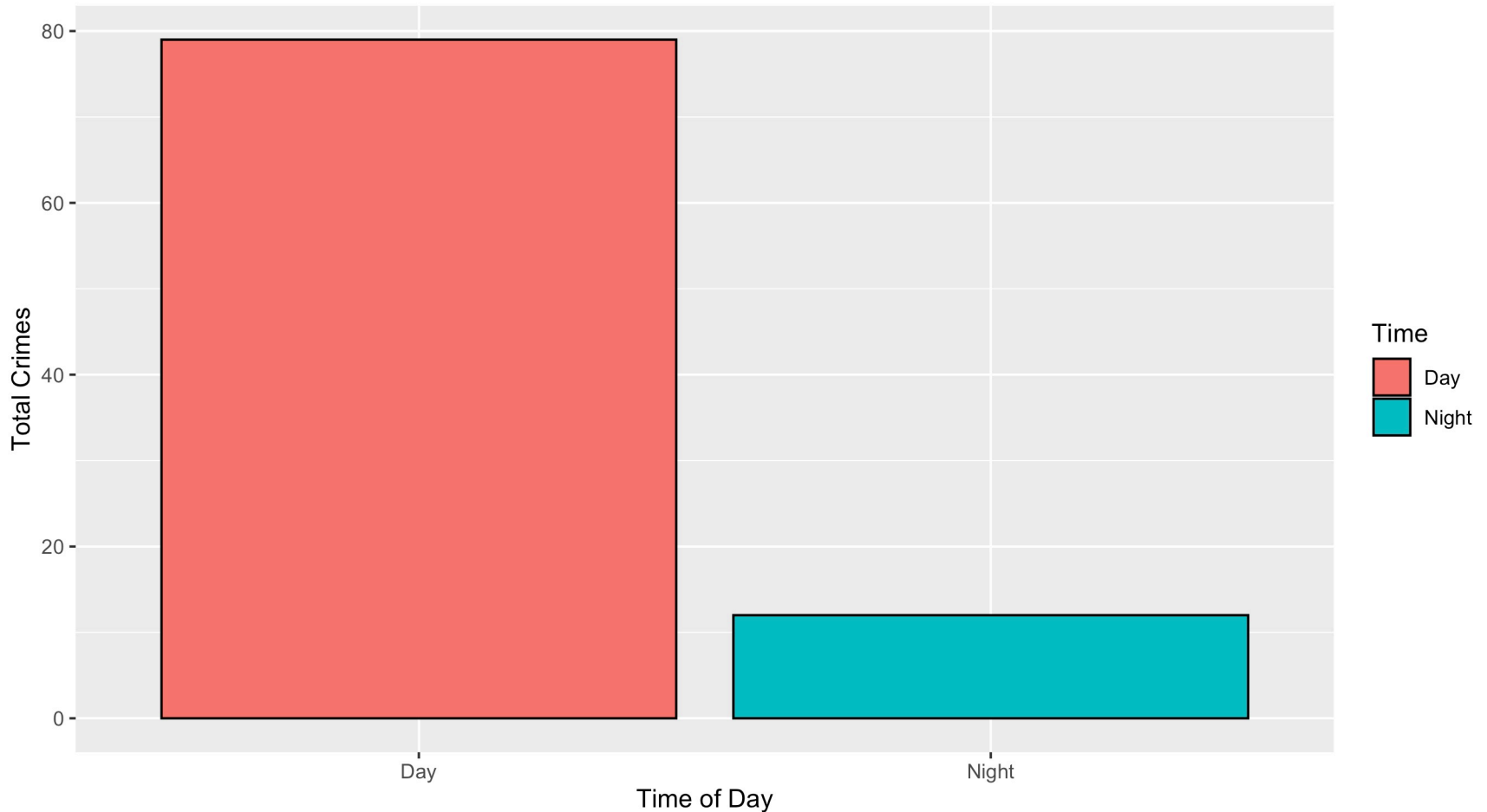

# Central West End: Total Crimes by Days of the Week

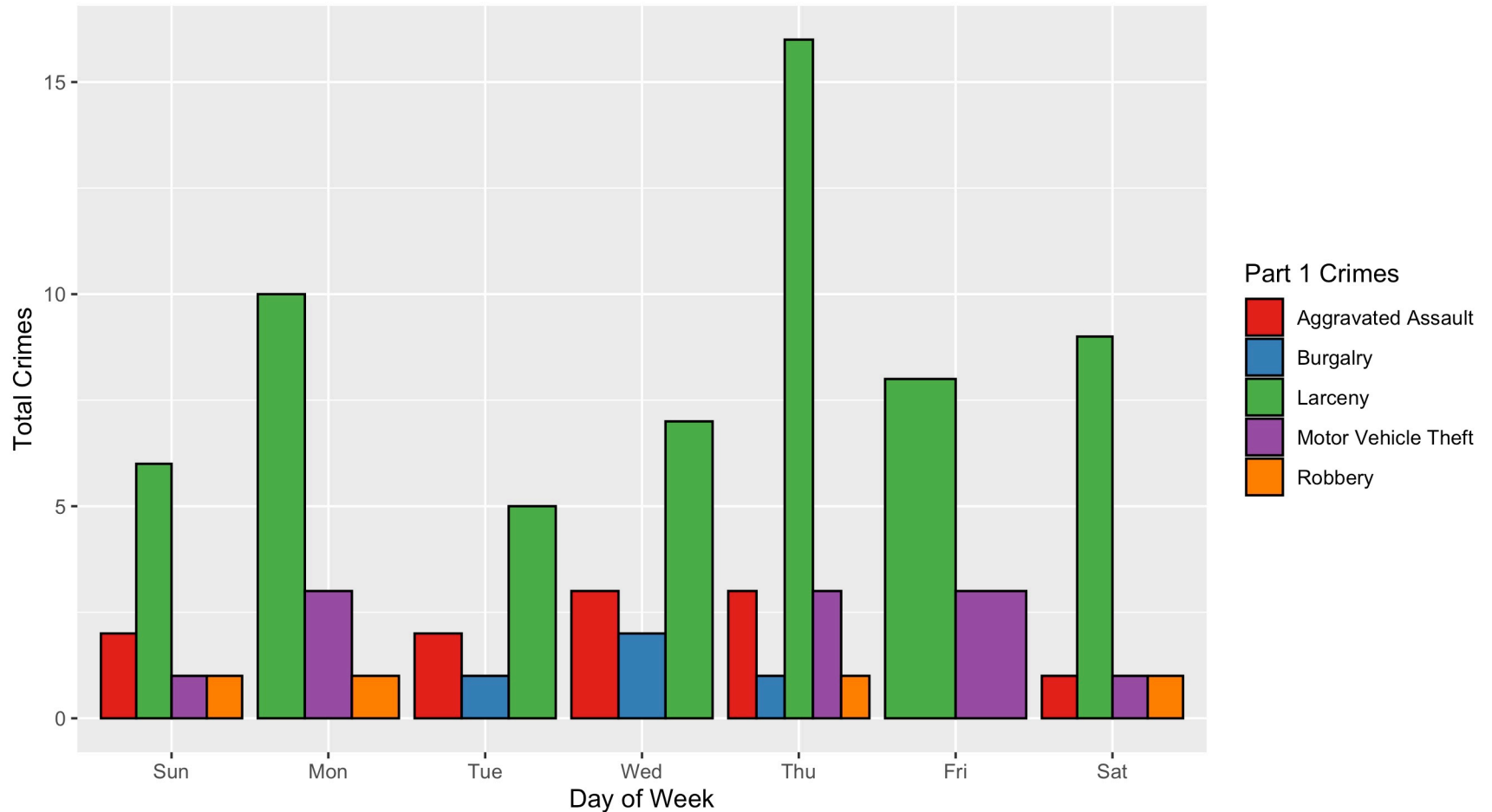




# Central West End: Crimes by Time of Day
