- ALLEY RECYCLING SHIFT: The [City of Saint Louis has shifted from alley recycling](#) to Drop-Off Recycling Locations due to extreme levels of contamination in shared alley dumpsters. Recycling drop-off locations have already proven to be a far more effective alternative to shared alley recycling. Drop-off sites are for residential use only and accept single stream recyclables. Ward 9 drop-off sites include
 - 4108 Clayton, off Sarah Street just north of Highway 40
 - 345 Whittier, next to the Schnucks off Lindell
 - 1660 S. Kingshighway, at the Water Division Lot
- MODOT BREAKS GROUND ON ROUTE 100 PROJECT: MoDOT has started its repaving project on Route 100 (Chouteau and Manchester) in the City. This project brings much needed safety
